Required Tools

Excerpt from the Job Referral Procedures of IATSE Local 835:

5. All persons are required to arrive at work calls with sufficient tools to perform assigned jobs. Failure to have the required tools at report time may subject the person to removal from the call with no compensation and this will be considered a no show. The tools must be in working order. Sufficient tools are defined as the following.

Hammer	Adjustable Wrench
Phillips head screwdriver	Slot head screwdriver
Arrow JT-21 Staple gun	Tape measure (25' minimum)
Utility knife	Tool belt or apron
Pliers	Wire cutters
Pry Bar	¼ inch drive ratchet with 5mm Allen
Pencil	

Excerpt from the Union's contract with the General Decorating Contractors:

ARTICLE 4 - TOOLS AND SUPPLIES

- 4.1 Each worker referred to the Company by the Union shall have in his or her possession suitable personal tools to accomplish his assigned duties. The tools shall consist of at least, but not limited to:
- a. Hammer
 - b. Screwdriver
 - c. Pliers
 - d. Crescent Wrench
 - e. Staple Gun (Arrow JT-21)
 - f. Phillips Screwdriver
 - g. Utility Knife, may be, razor knife, etc.
 - h. Tape Measure (25' min.)
 - i. Top carpet cutter - Journeymen only
 - j. Loop pile carpet cutter - Journeymen only.
 - k. Pry bar
 - l. Wire cutters (Diagonal)
 - m. One set each standard and metric allen wrenches
 - n. One set each open and box end wrenches
 - o. Tool belt or apron
 - p. Battery operated screw gun (7.2 volts or higher and tips) - Journeymen only
- 4.2 Any worker referred to the Company without appropriate tools shall thereby waive any rights to minimum call time.
